**Historic Days in St. George's** (King's Square, Town of St. George) 12:00noon, King's Square, Town of St. George. Relive the past through some entertaining and mischievous historical reenactments. Free. Info: 297-1532.

**The Crystal Caves of Bermuda** (Wilkinson Ave, Bailey's Bay Bus Routes 1, 3, 10 & 11) 9.30am-4.30pm Daily. Explore Crystal & Fantasy Caves and discover Bermuda's true hidden treasures of delicate crystal formations. Rare chandelier clusters of soda straw formations adorn the Fantasy cave ceiling with deep pools of water connected to the ocean. Crystal Cave features a 55ft deep azure blue underground lake with formations clearly visible underwater and stalactites above. Cost: \$14/adult each cave or \$20 for both caves, \$8/children 5-12 each cave or \$18 for both. Call 293-0640.

**Bermuda Aquarium, Museum & Zoo** (Flatts Village, Hamilton Parish) Open daily 9:00am-5:00pm. Tour the 145,000-gallon North Rock coral reef tank and the Islands of Australasia Exhibit, visit lemurs from Madagascar and enjoy the Discovery Cove or stroll the Coastal Walkway with its breathtaking view of Harrington Sound. Price: \$10 per adult, \$5 children 5-12/seniors and under 5 free. (Last admission 4pm).

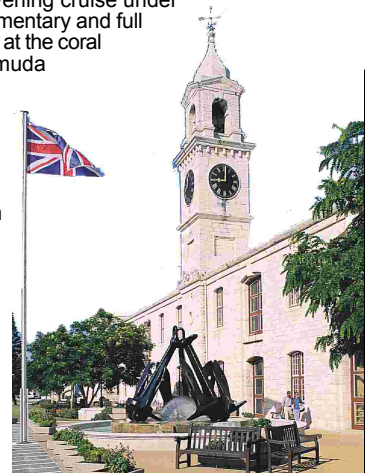
